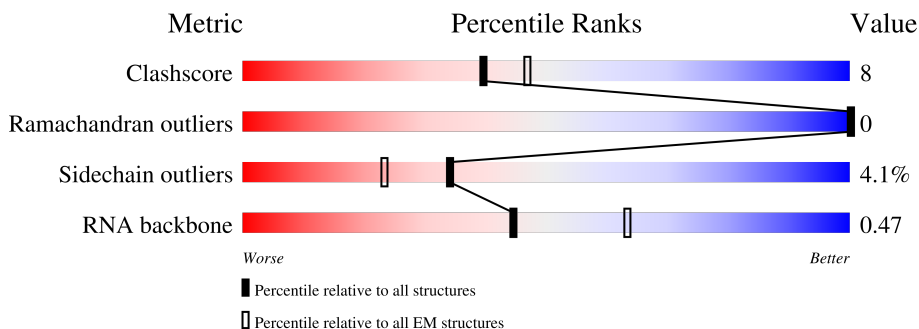
1 Overall quality at a glance

The following experimental techniques were used to determine the structure:

ELECTRON MICROSCOPY

The reported resolution of this entry is 3.10 Å.

The table below summarises the geometric issues observed across the polymeric chains and their fit to the map. The red, orange, yellow and green segments of the bar indicate the fraction of residues that contain outliers for ≥ 3 , 2, 1 and 0 types of geometric quality criteria respectively. A grey segment represents the fraction of residues that are not modelled. The numeric value for each fraction is indicated below the corresponding segment, with a dot representing fractions $\leq 5\%$. The upper red bar (where present) indicates the fraction of residues that have poor fit to the EM map (all-atom inclusion $< 40\%$). The numeric value is given above the bar.

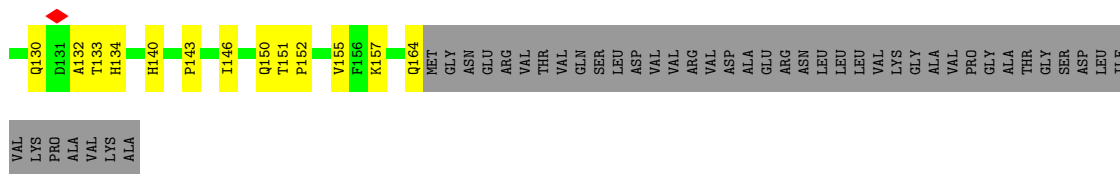

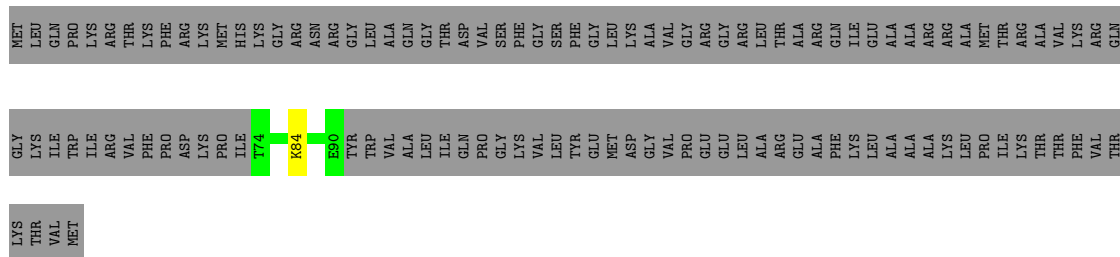

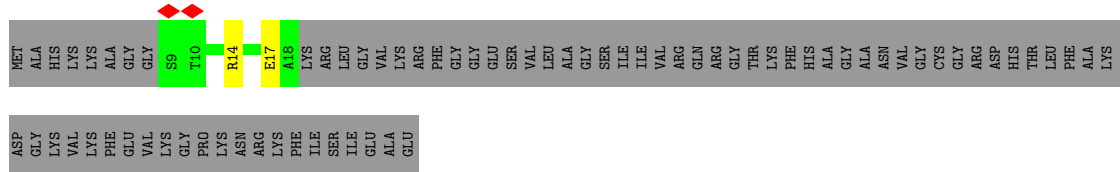
• Molecule 4: 50S ribosomal protein L16

Chain N: 12% . 88%



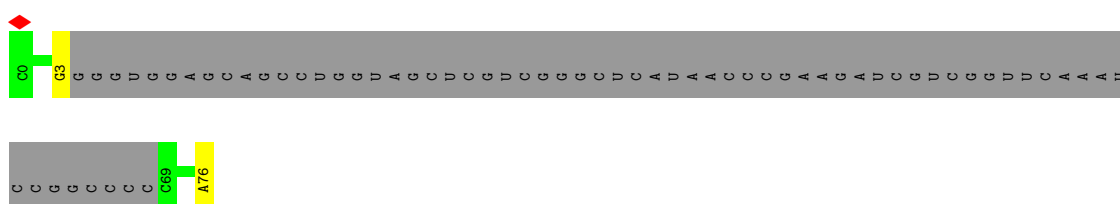
• Molecule 5: 50S ribosomal protein L27

Chain X: 9% . 88%



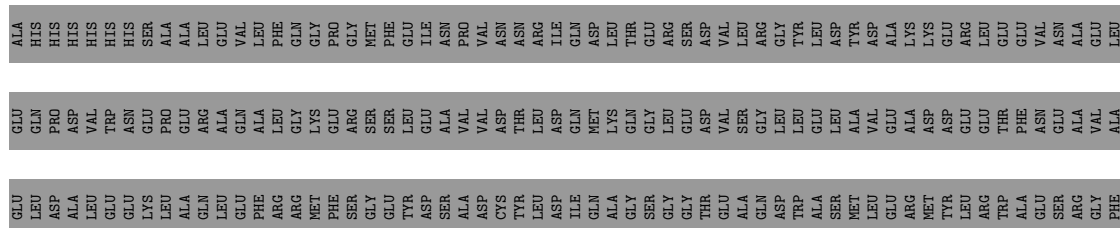
• Molecule 6: P-site tRNA fMet

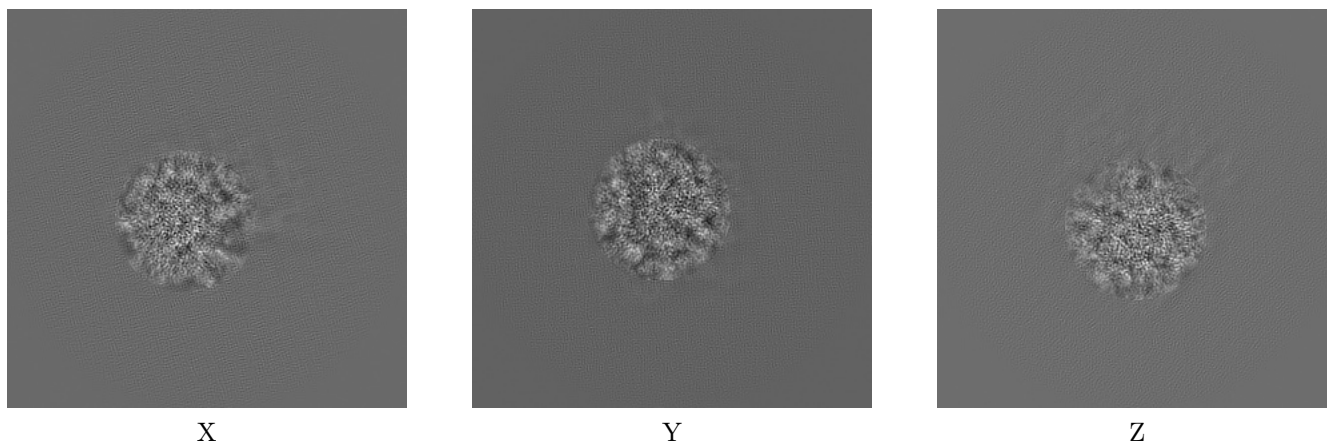

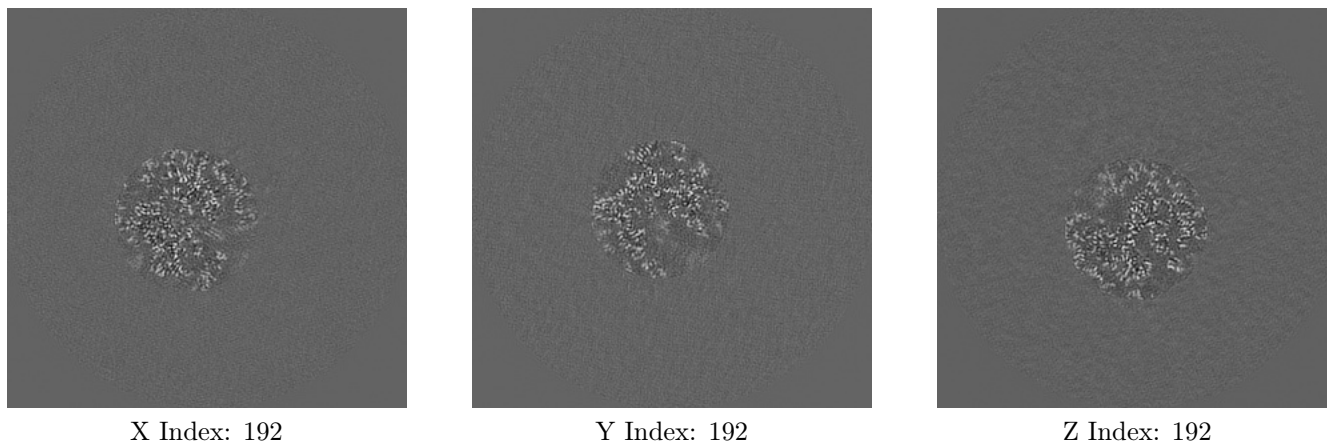

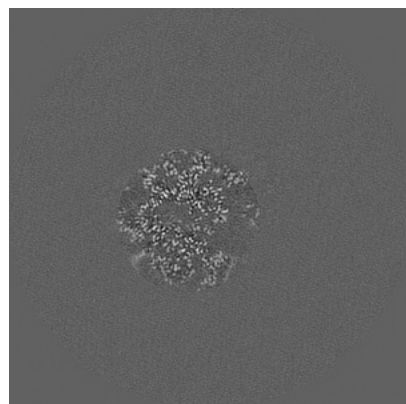

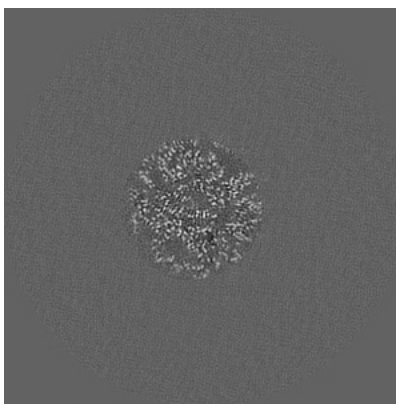

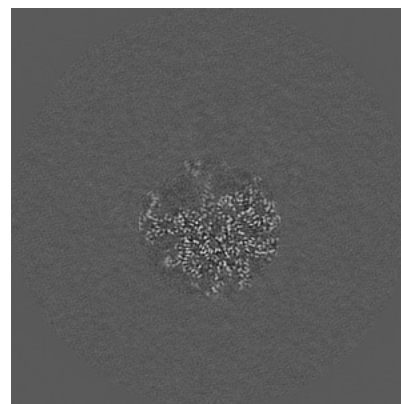

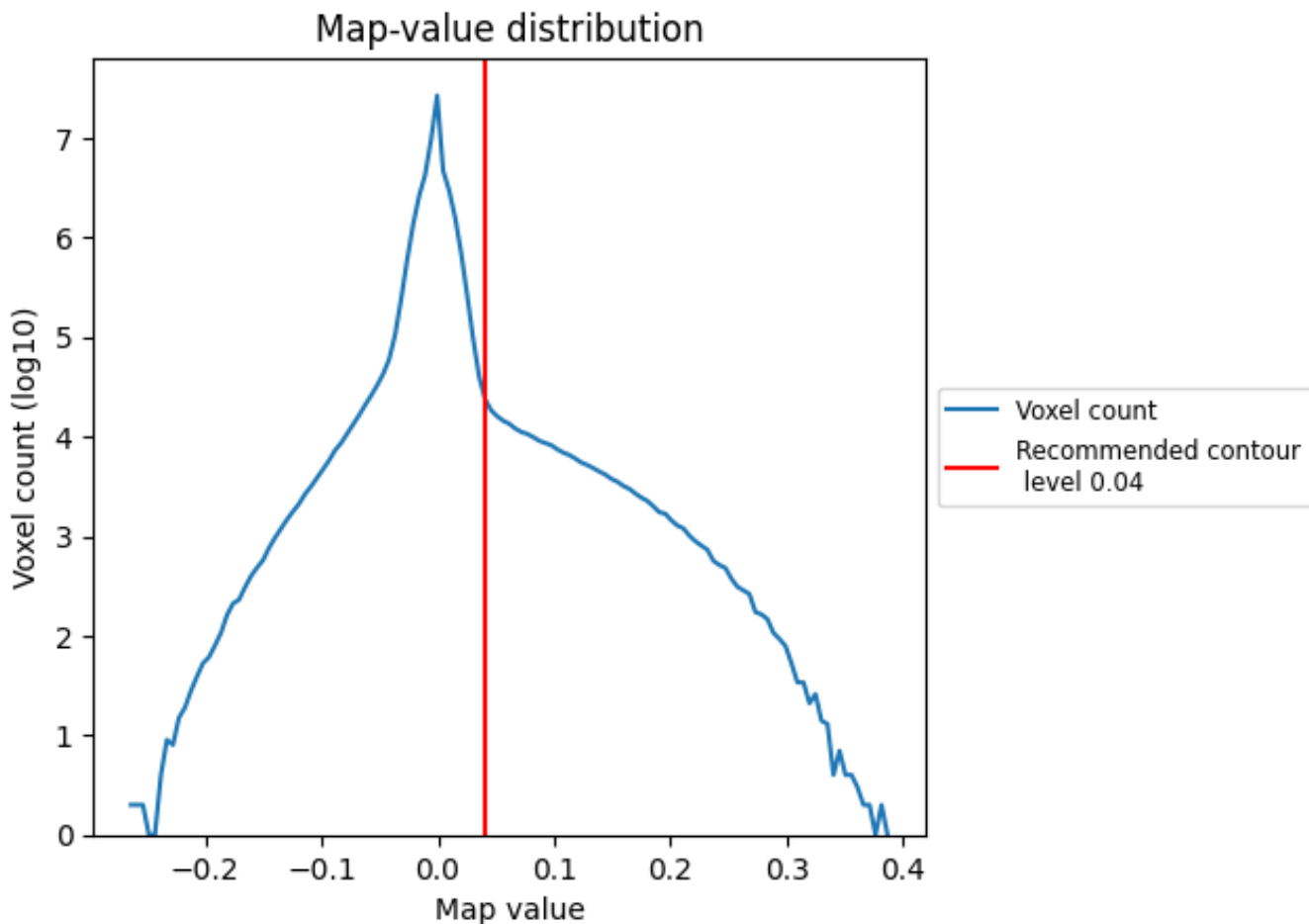

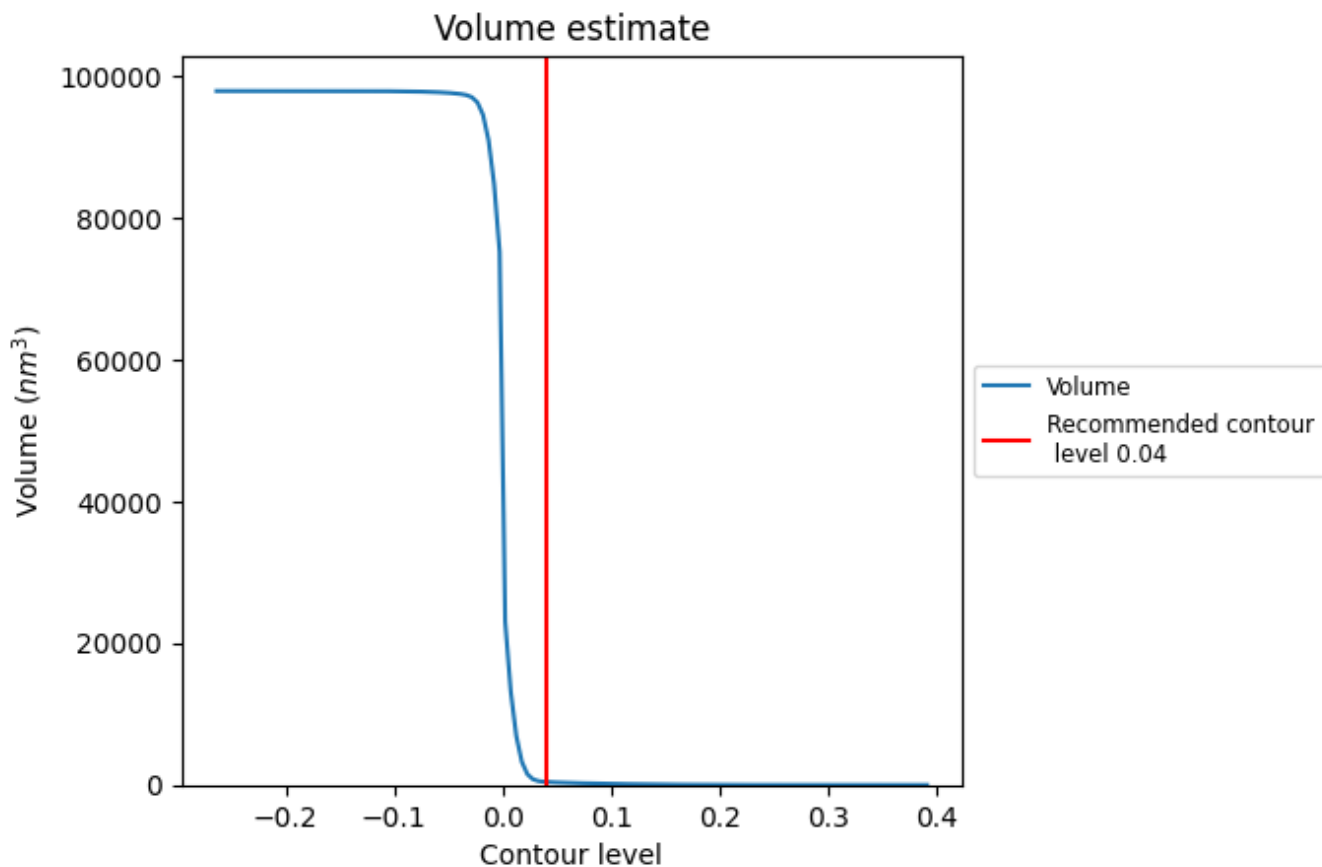

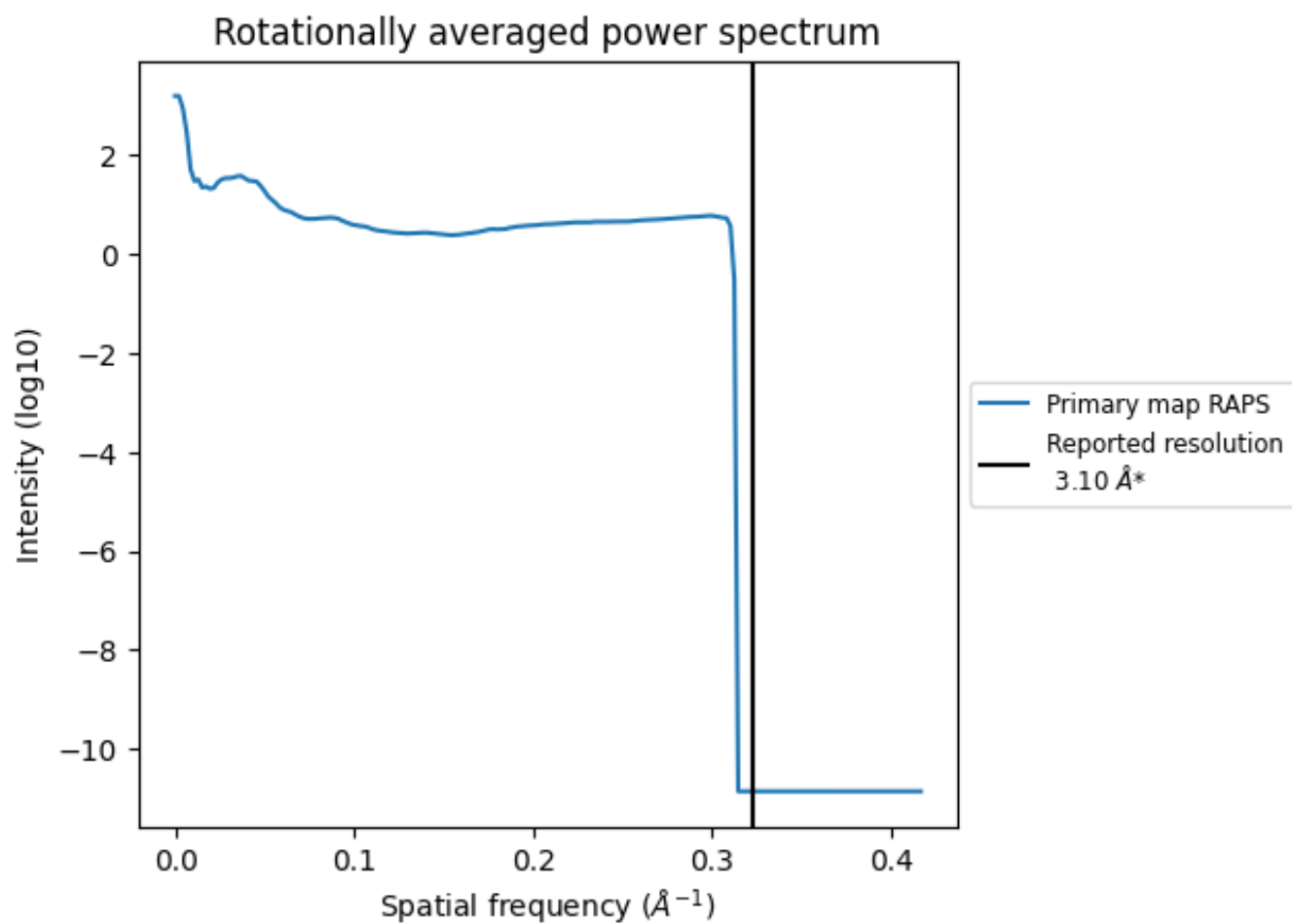

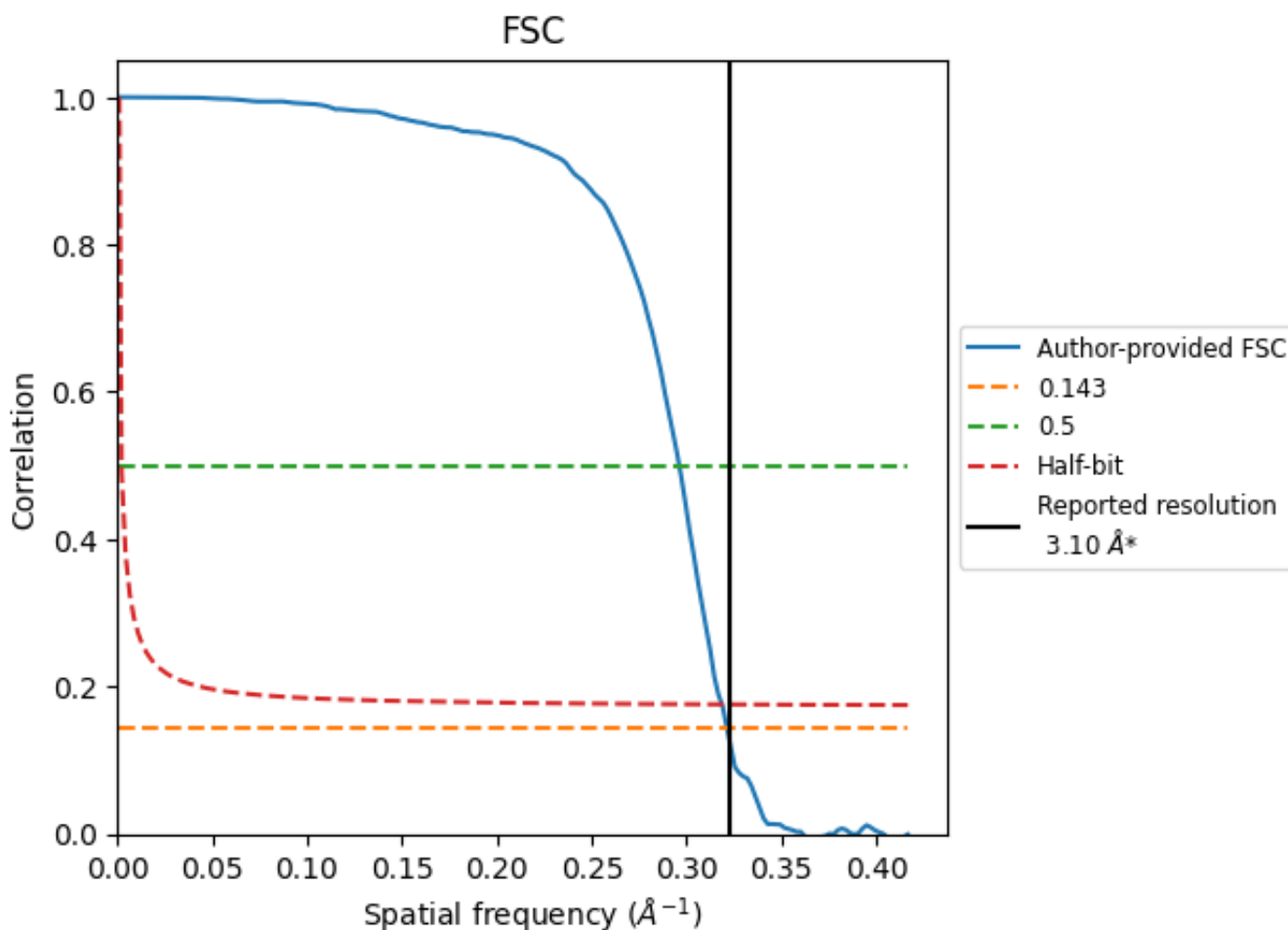

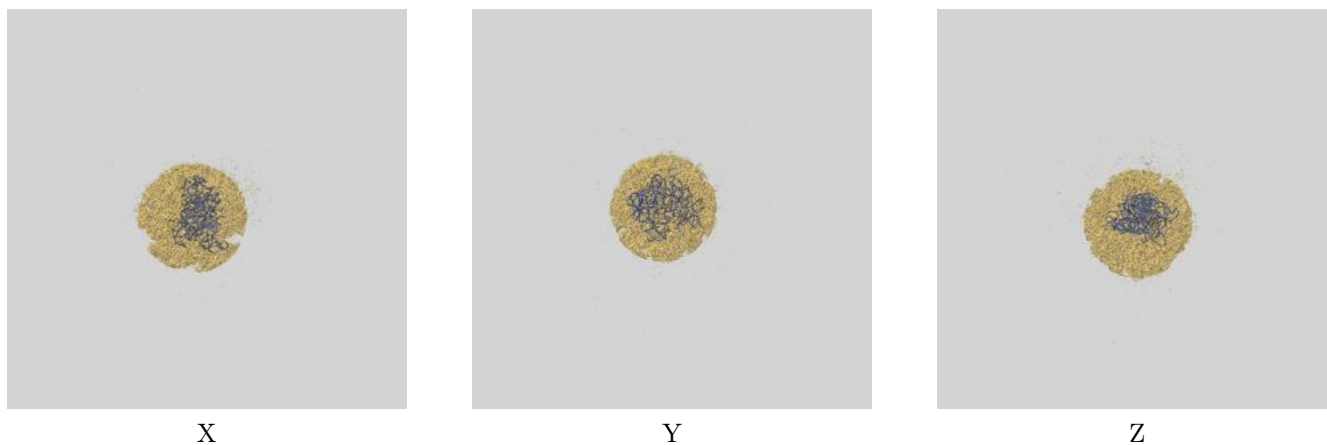

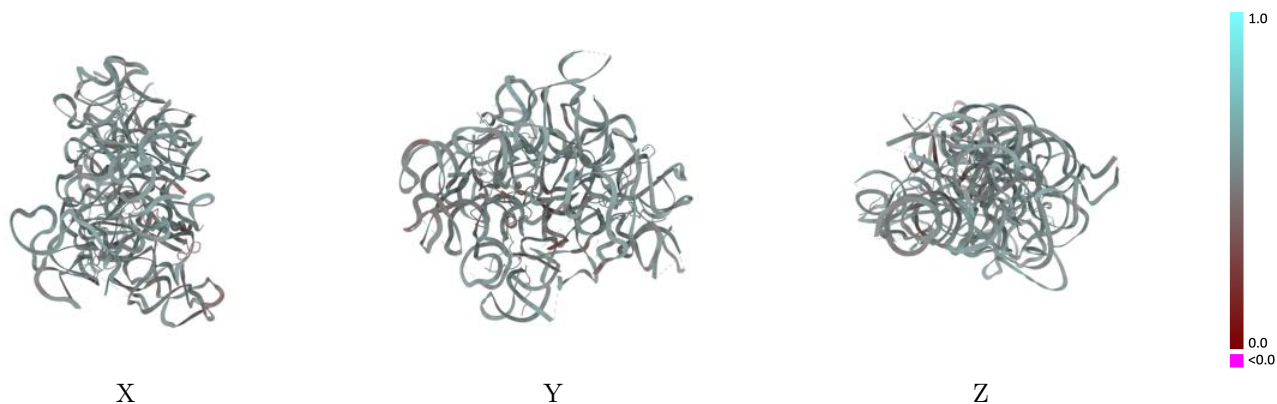

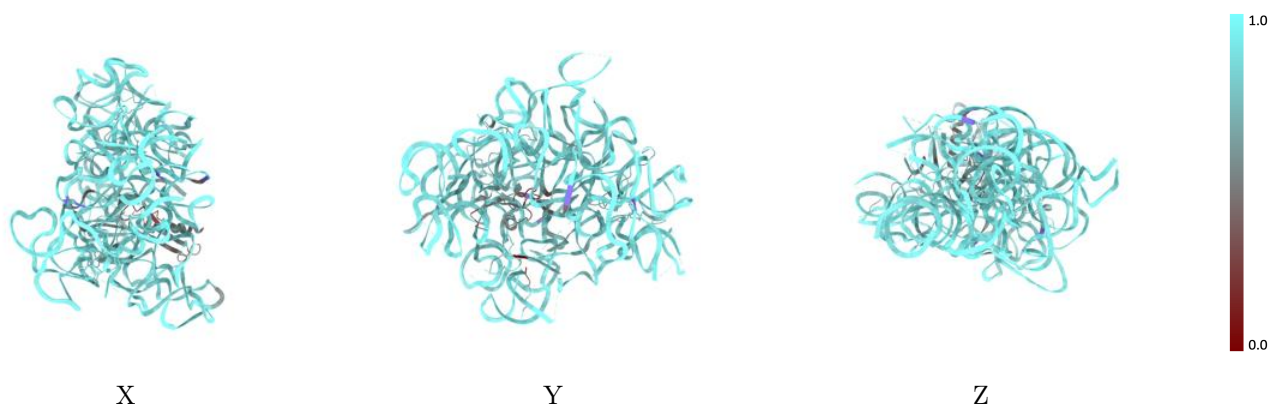

9.2 Q-score mapped to coordinate model [i](#)



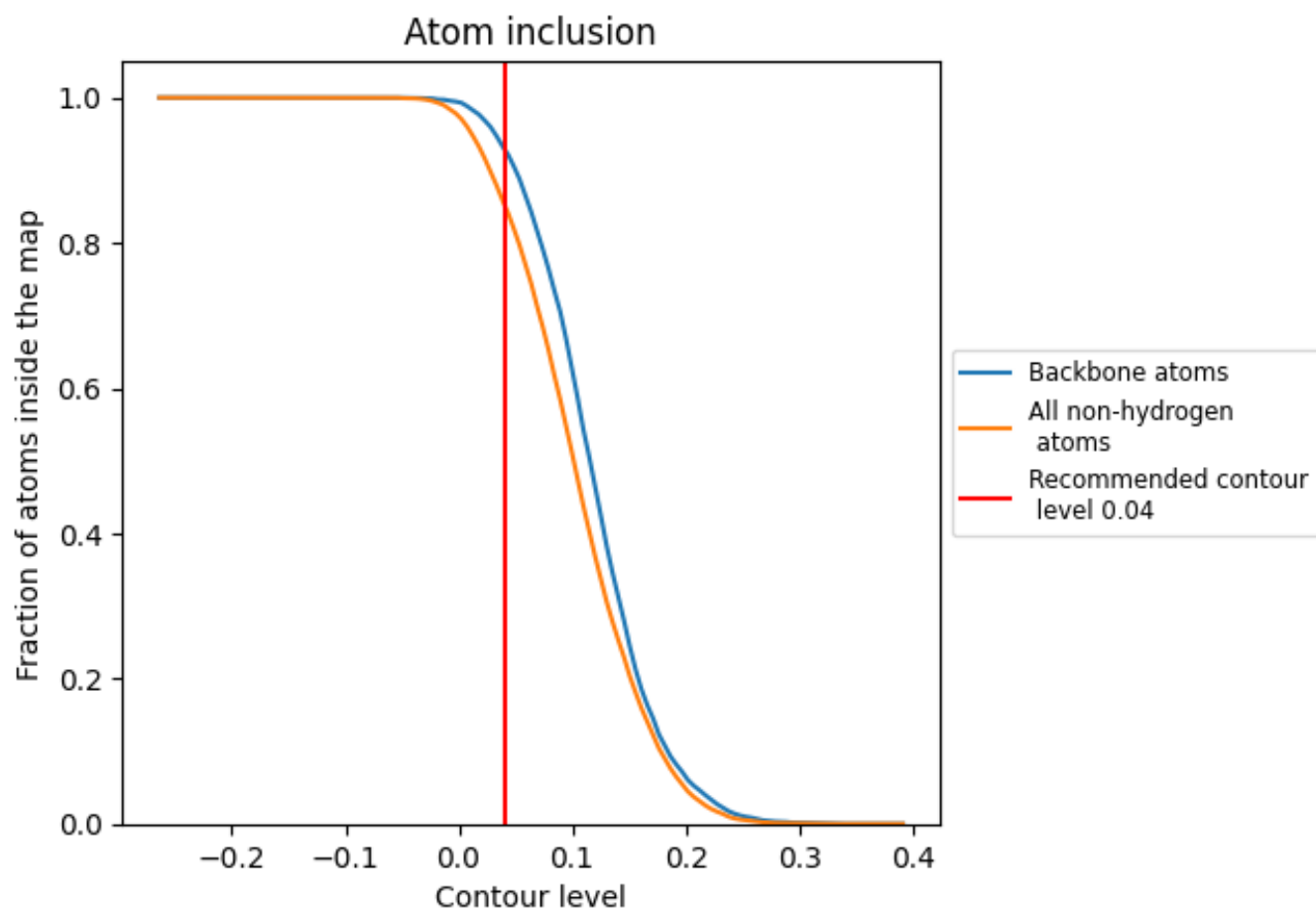

The images above show the model with each residue coloured according to its atom inclusion. This shows to what extent they are inside the map at the recommended contour level (0.04).

















9.4 Atom inclusion [i](#)



At the recommended contour level, 93% of all backbone atoms, 85% of all non-hydrogen atoms, are inside the map.
